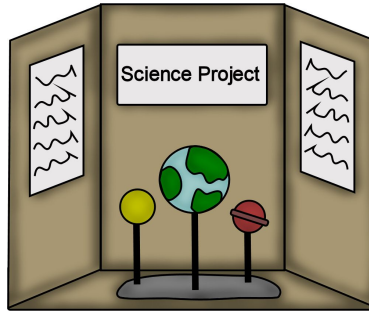


## 2018 Lansing Middle School STEAM month Science Fair

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### General Science Fair Guidelines:

Students will have approximately half of a table (approx 3ft x 2.5ft per project) for display/presentation of their project. Students may work in groups up to 4 or may work on their project alone.

A tri-fold or similar sized display board including basic key points:

- Title
- Hypothesis
- Materials
- Methods
- Data/Results
- Conclusions
- Miscellaneous - name, grade, helpers, thank you's

Display board may include writing, pictures, photos, diagrams, etc. No formal write up is required beyond a basic display including the key points.

\*Note: Foam board and tri-fold boards can typically be found at the dollar store.
