REOPENING 2020

Elementary School Students In-Person and Distance Learning

KINDERGARTEN

Students entering kindergarten would attend in-person school half-days Monday-Thursday, either AM or PM. Virtual learning will occur opposite of in-person instruction. We hope to provide childcare through our School Aged Childcare Program on opposite of in-person instruction. For example, if your child attends an AM in person instructional block, childcare would be available for the PM block and vice versa. Friday would be virtual instruction, review and check in as necessary.

- In-person half days and virtual half days
- Virtual on Fridays
- This allows for consistent in-person contact in small groups of 10 or less.
- At this time, childcare would not be offered on Fridays through our School Aged Childcare Program.

FIRST GRADE

Students entering for first grade would attend in-person school 4 full days Monday-Thursday. Friday would be virtual instruction, review and check in as necessary. We would be adding additional sections of 1st grade to create small classes of 12 or less.

- This allows for consistent in-person contact in small groups of 12 or less.
- At this time, childcare would not be offered on Friday's through our School Aged Childcare Program.

GRADES 2-4

Students in grades 2-4 would attend in-person school 2 back to back full days either Monday and Tuesday or Wednesday and Thursday. Opposite in-person days would be virtual instruction. Friday would be virtual instruction, review and check in as necessary. We hope to provide childcare through our School Aged Childcare program on days your child is not receiving in-person instruction.

- This allows for consistent in-person contact in small groups of 12 or less.
- At this time, childcare would not be offered on Friday's through our School Aged Childcare Program.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS

Some students may receive academic and special program supports in class and/or virtually and some may receive academic and special programs in an additional location.

ENCORE

Encore classes will be held in-person and/or virtually. In-person classes will be in the small group either in the students assigned classrooms or outside.

EXTRACURRICULARS/CLUBS

We continue to await guidance from NYSED and NYS regarding extracurricular options. However, we do not believe we will be able to provide in person options until later in the year.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation would be provided. Students will have assigned seating and would be expected to follow all social distancing and mask wearing guideline set forth by NYSED and NYS.

FOOD SERVICE

Students will be able to bring or purchase breakfast and lunch. Both meals will be provided in the classrooms.

We hope to provide childcare through our School Aged Childcare Program on opposite sides of instruction for students in grades 5-6. Friday would be virtual instruction, review and check in as necessary for all students.

- In-person every other day and virtual every other day, all students virtual on Friday
- This allows for consistent in-person contact in small groups of 12 or less.
- At this time, childcare would not be offered on Friday's through our School Aged Childcare Program.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS

ENCORE

Encore classes will be held in-person and/ or virtually. In person classes will be in the small group either in the students assigned classrooms, a separate location or outside.

ENCORE

Encore classes will be held in-person and/or virtually. In person classes will be in the small group either in the students assigned classrooms, a separate location or outside.

EXTRACURRICULAR/CLUBS

We continue to await guidance from NYSED and NYS regarding extracurricular options. However, we do not believe we will be able to provide in person options until later in the year.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation would be provided. Students will have assigned seating and would be expected to follow all social distancing and mask wearing guideline set forth by NYSED and NYS. Monitors will be placed on every elementary school bus.

FOOD SERVICE

Students will be able to bring or purchase breakfast and lunch. Both meals will be provided in the classrooms.
