# Welcome to First Grade!!

Here is a list of the supplies you will need for First Grade.

## **PLEASE DO NOT LABEL THESE SUPPLIES (classroom supplies):**

- 12 pencils yellow #2 (Ticonderoga work best)
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 2 sets of 8 markers (large/conical tip, standard colors)
- 2 pink rectangular erasers
- 5 large glue sticks (over 1 ounce each)
- 6-10 dry erase markers - dark colors (EXPO brand work best)

## **PLEASE LABEL THESE SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME:**

- 3 plastic pocket folders (write first and last name on front)
- Small safety scissors (Wescott or Fiskar work well)
- 1 spiral notebook (70-100 pages)
- Small plastic pencil box (8" x 5" x 2") \*\*\* Please do **not** send in larger boxes
- Backpack to bring every day
- Sneakers for Phys. Ed. (daily)

## **WISH LIST OF ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:**

- Ziplock baggies - boys/gallon size, girls/quart or sandwich size
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 containers of Clorox Wipes

## Supply List for Second Grade

We know this is quite a supply list.  
These supplies will be saved and will hopefully last for the entire year.

- \_\_\_ 24 **yellow** sharpened #2 pencils

- \_\_\_ optional 1 box of Kleenex

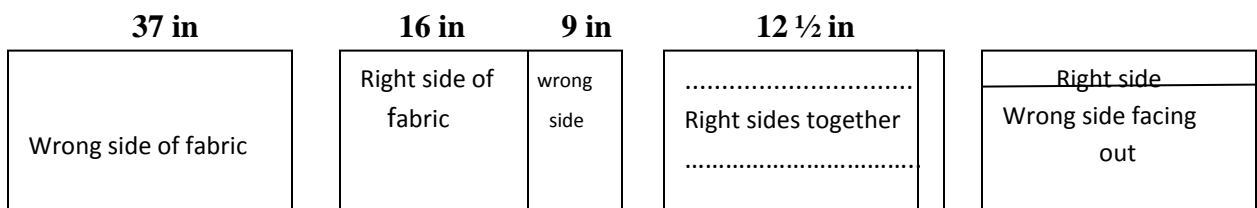


### ***DIRECTIONS FOR CHAIR POCKET***

A retired second grade teacher came up with this fantastic idea! Your child will use the chair pocket to store books on the back of their chair. It helps with organization. The directions for making one are fairly simple. If you don't sew, simply supply the material and one will be made for you. If you do sew and would like to help us out, please send in an extra one or volunteer to sew for other parents. Thanks!

Directions:

1. You will need  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of fabric (preferably cotton or cotton blend). Cut it to measure 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches by 37 inches. Send this fabric to school or go to steps 2-5.
2. Make a narrow hem on the 2 edges that are 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long.
3. Fold up on 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch edge, right sides together for 9 inches. Pin in place.
4. Fold the other 16  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch edge down over the top of the previously folded piece-again right sides together, with the edge matching the bottom fold.
5. Stitch the two raw edges together. Turn, like a pillow case, and it's done!



*Following the above directions will create a chair pocket that is inside out. This can be changed by cutting the fabric if you'd like. This step was left out to keep the directions as simple as possible.*

## The Third-Grade Supply List

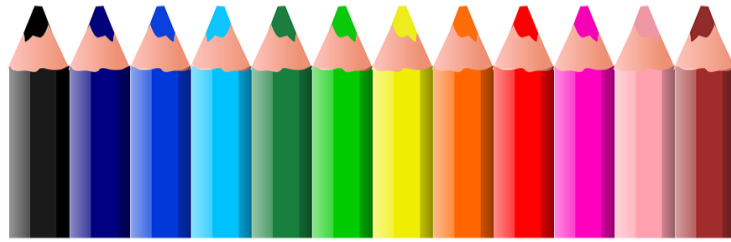


**Supplies will be pooled (Please do not label!)**

- 2 dozen pencils, **sharpened**, Ticonderoga preferred
- 2 packs of 3" x 3" sticky notes (100 sheets each)
- 2 four-packs of Expo dry erase markers, fine-point preferred
- 4 erasers (standard pink or white type)
- Colored pencils, 1 pack of 12 (approx.)
- Markers, 1 pack
- One pencil box - plastic - 5 x 8 x 2 inches

## Fourth Grade Supply List\* 2017-2018

- One pair of scissors
- Five 3" x 3" pads of sticky notes
  - Four dozen #2 pencils

- Ten dry erase markers, dark colors
  - One YELLOW highlighter
  - One composition notebook
  - One 12 pack of colored pencils
- Twelve 2 pocket folders: two yellow, two red, two blue, two green, two purple, two black
