Entering and Exiting the Building

School Starts - 7:49am

School Ends - 2:30pm

- Bus drop off will be in the tennis court parking lot, and a crossing guard will cross students
- Family Drop Off - **not before 7:35** (we can't have lines)
 - 5th and 6th - front circle
 - 7th and 8th - circle by gym doors
- Students Enter
 - 5th - front entrance
 - 6th - door by Mrs. VanArnum's room
 - 7th - door by gymnasium/cafe (Mr. Scheffler's door)
 - 8th - door to right of gym (Bottom of 8th grade stairwell)

Entering and Exiting the Building cont.

Upon entering the building, students:

- Must be wearing a mask
- Will be greeted and checked in while maintaining social distancing (6 feet)
- Will be screened if necessary
- Have the opportunity to “grab and go” breakfast in the cafe line
- Go to their lockers
- Go to their Pod Room to get ready for first period

Upon exiting the building, students:

- Exit through the designated door
- Will be picked up in the same locations as they were dropped off

Health Screener

- Families are an integral part of helping us keep our school healthy. Screening for Covid 19 related symptoms, including temperature, will be reported from home each day
- At school, we will follow up with anyone who we do know show was already screened in the morning
- Please let students know that they may have their temperature taken at school, especially on the orientation days until our screener is up and running
- Families will receive a Google Form called “Daily Health Screener” for orientation day
- Please keep your child home if they have a fever of 100 or more

Cohorts, Pods & Instruction

- ALL STUDENTS, 100% virtual and hybrid:
 - Have been assigned to a Mon/Wed (Blue) or Tues/Th (Gold) cohort
 - Have been assigned a pod (either hybrid or virtual)
- Hybrid students will attend in person on the days of their assigned cohort and following the schedule will have either asynchronous or synchronous on the opposite days
- 100% virtual students will follow the schedule and will have synchronous instruction on their assigned cohort day and either synchronous or asynchronous on the opposite days

Cohorts, Pods & Instruction, cont.

- All students have asynchronous learning on Fridays with teacher office hours available from 2-3 pm
- Teachers will orient the students and will invite students to virtual classes and meets using email or Google Classroom
- 5th Grade has 2 self contained pods (one teacher for ELA/Math/Science and Social Studies) and 2 pods that are shared between two teachers
- 6th Grade has 4 self contained pods

Cohorts, Pods & Instruction, cont.

- 7th Grade has 5 pods (one virtual)
 - Teachers are assigned and will travel to the pods, except for language classes, advanced math and some encore classes
- 8th Grade has 5 pods (one virtual)
 - Teachers are assigned and will travel to the pods, except for language classes and some encore classes

Schedules

Schedules are tentative at this point

Students using the hybrid model will receive a copy of their schedules on the day they attend orientation

The important information you need to have is where your child goes first period (or signs in if 100% virtual).

- You will be able to view your child's tentative schedule in SchoolTool (Note that 6th grade students start with PE, Library, or CTE(Career and Technical Education) class. They will be assigned to a pod room for the day, which is where they will go first period.
- **ALL STUDENTS, virtual and hybrid will receive an email either stating where they should report for first period or how and where they should sign in virtually during the orientation days.**
- Schedules include locker numbers and combinations

- Tues/Thurs (gold) cohort attends all day, in person on Tuesday, September 15th.
- During the rest of the week there will be asynchronous activities and some scheduled meets or check ins. More info on this will be shared by teachers.

Orientation Days for 100% Virtual Model:

- Mon/Wed (blue) cohort attends virtually on Monday, September 14th.
 - Google meet times will be shared with students by pod, class or period.
- Tues/Thurs cohort attends virtually on Tuesday, September 15th.
 - Google meet times will be shared with students by pod, class or period.
- During the rest of the week there will be asynchronous activities and some scheduled meets or check ins. More info on this will be shared by teachers.
