DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS LANSING CENTRAL SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

If a student violates bus rules he/she will be written up on a Bus Behavior Report. The following disciplinary actions will be taken:

- 1st Offense Bus behavior report will be signed by parent and returned to the driver the next day.
- 2nd Offense Conference with student, parent, driver, building principal, transportation supervisor.
 Possible loss of bus privileges depending upon infraction.
- 3rd Offense Conference with student, parent, driver, building principal, and transportation supervisor resulting in loss of privileges for 3 or more days.

Chronic or severe discipline problems will be referred to the Superintendent for long-term suspension from bus transportation.

The following behaviors will result in a Bus Behavior Report:

- 1. Disobeying and/or distracting driver
- 2. Failing to stay seated for whatever reason, being in aisles when bus is in motion
- 3. Placing body parts outside of window (hands, head, etc.)
- 4. Tampering with emergency equipment or misuse of seat belts
- 5. Excessive loudness, rudeness
- 6. Pushing/horseplay
- 7. Using profane/abusive language
- 8. Throwing objects on/off/at bus
- 9. Damaging bus property
- 10. Eating/drinking/littering
- 11. Violating safety rules (crossing, etc.)
- 12. Other minor infractions

IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION from bus transportation is warranted if the following violations occur:

- 1. Fighting, involving physical contact, striking another
- 2. Possessing/using alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco
- 3. Possessing a dangerous object
- 4. Directing profanity at the driver
- 5. Assaulting/intimidating the driver
- 6. Obstructing the driver's vision
- 7. Sexually explicit behavior (harassment, abuse, exposure, etc.)
- 8. Other major infractions
