What does this mean?

- Our students at all ages will be more involved in their CSE meeting and what happens after the meeting (in their education)

Students' role will be matched to their abilities and comfort level



- Science is my favorite
- Math is hard but I'm feeling good about it this year
- Reading
- Writing
- PE and Art





Why are we doing this?

- Student-directed IEPs are a great way for students to increase the important life skill of *self-determination*.

Self Determination:

Includes letting people know <u>what you think</u>, <u>making decisions</u> for yourself, <u>setting</u> <u>goals</u>, and <u>working towards them</u>.

It is linked to increases in academic skills, employment, wages, postsecondary education, and an improved quality of life.

Before an Annual Review CSE Meeting...

Students work with their case managers to discuss and understand:

- their strengths
- the things that are challenging for them
- how they learn best (preferences)
- their academic/social/behavioral/emotional goals
