TCIS Training

- Therapeutic Crisis Intervention in Schools (TCIS)
- 15 Lansing and Groton Staff participated in this week-long training
- TCIS is a crisis prevention and intervention curriculum created by Cornell University's Residential Child Care Project
- Designed to teach staff how to help at-risk children learn constructive ways to handle crisis
- The TCI system assists organizations in preventing crises from occurring, de-escalating potential crises, managing acute physical behavior, reducing potential and actual injury to children and staff, teaching children adaptive coping strategies, and developing a learning organization.
