We are pleased to announce that all students enrolled at R.C. Buckley Elementary School, Lansing Middle School, and Lansing High School will be able to receive one FREE breakfast and lunch meal each day at school beginning on November 1, 2023.

This implementation is a result of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) expanding access to the federal Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). CEP allows eligible schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs to offer school meals at no charge to all students.

What does this mean for your child(ren) attending the school(s) identified above? Effective November 1, 2023, all students enrolled at R.C. Buckley Elementary School, Lansing Middle School, and Lansing High School will receive meals at no cost to your household. No further action is required of you.
