Pupil/ Parent/ Bus Driver Relationship

- 1. Know the regular bus driver's name and the number of the a.m. and p.m. buses.
- 2. Assist the bus driver in maintaining the schedule. If for any reason you are not going to school, please call the bus garage at 533-4608. If possible, let us know at this time when you will return. Unnecessary delays can be avoided if you will call the bus garage.
- 3. Special needs will be considered (medical, special seating, babysitting changes, etc.) with proper notification to the bus garage. If getting off other than at the regular stop (home or day care provider), please bring a note from your parent or guardian to the school office in the morning of that day.
- 4. Do not distract the bus driver unless there is an emergency.
- 5. Obey driver's directions promptly.
- 6. Be courteous and cooperative with the driver and other students.
- 7. Do not talk loudly or use profane/abusive language.
- 8. Keep bus clean and free of litter.
- 9. Keep head, arms, etc. inside of bus.
- 10. Do not tamper with emergency doors, windows, or equipment.
- 11. Remain seated facing forward at all times.
- 12. No eating or drinking on regular bus routes.
- 13. Participate in all Fire/Emergency drills (3 times a year).
- 14. Do not throw paper, clothing, backpacks etc. on or off the bus.
- 15. Obey all other school rules while riding the school bus.
