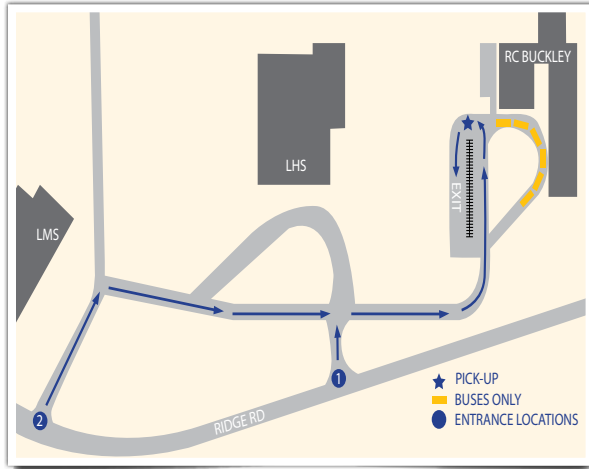
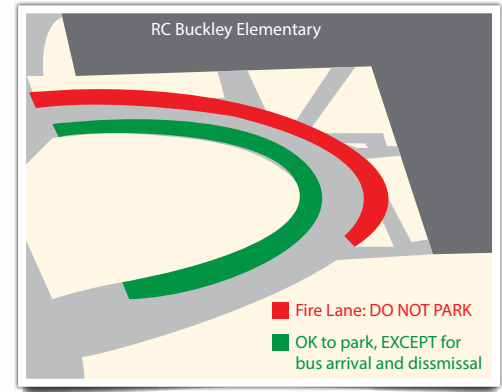

TRAFFIC FLOW PATTERNS

Parents/Guardians who drop off or pick up their child at RC Buckley are reminded that safety is our first priority. The traffic circle directly in front of the building is designated for school buses. The curb lane is also the school's designated emergency lane and a "No Parking" zone. Cars are not allowed in the bus loop during arrival or dismissal. **Drop-off BEGINS at 8:43 am.**

Please use the drop-off circle (left of the building/edge of the parking lot). A staff member will open your vehicle door and assist your child(ren) out of the vehicle. The driver stays in the car. To keep traffic flowing, please watch for directions from staff members guiding traffic. The staff members will direct vehicles to the bus loop once we have confirmed all buses have exited the elementary campus. Students will enter the building by specific grade level doors. Staff members are there to assist students.



DISMISSAL PICK-UP PROCEDURE

We are committed to ensuring that every child being picked up at the end of the day leaves safely with their parent or guardian. Parents/guardians need to enter the campus near the main entrance in front of the electronic District sign (in front of the High School) and turn right towards the Elementary School (if traffic is backed up, enter the campus in front of the Middle School). Vehicles will line up in the parent/guardian pick-up circle (the section to the left of the building when facing the building). Once we have identified you as someone with the authority to pick up, a staff member will help your child(ren) get into the vehicle. It is important that whenever possible students exit and enter their vehicles from the passenger (right-hand) side for their safety. We would prefer students to crawl across the backseat when possible instead of entering from the other door. Adults picking up students remain in their vehicle during this procedure. Please drive cautiously and watch for staff members' directions and signals. There is no need to arrive before 3:15 pm.
