Board Of Education Goals

1. Continue professional development and training to improve our effectiveness and satisfy mandates.
  - a. Hold an annual BOE retreat, including a slot dedicated to new board member orientation.
  - b. Hold workshop to discuss and confirm BOE and district goals.
  - c. Attend NYSSBA/CNYSBA and other trainings in a fiscally responsive manner.
  - d. Use archived and future NYSSBA webinars for individual training.
  - e. BOE members who attend NYSSBA should give a five minute presentation on how their participation helps the district or helped with their own professional development as a board member (financial accountability).
  - f. At the end of the school year, evaluate goal completion.
  
2. Complete an annual review of the superintendent.
  - a. Review superintendent's goals.
  - b. Review for SuperEval for possible adoption.
  
3. Improve public communication
  - a. Select a board member to attend town meetings
  - b. BOE SDM representatives should report to full board on meetings.
  - c. Reach out to under-represented groups for participation.
  - d. Explore opportunities to go out into the community to collect feedback.
  
4. Improve board and superintendent work operations
  - a. Request an annotated agenda from the superintendent before the day of a board meeting
  - b. Rotate attendance of board members to agenda planning meetings with the superintendent, president, and vice-president giving each member at least one meeting.
  - c. Decide by May 2019 whether BOE members should serve on negotiations team.
  
5. Support district efforts to improve the culture and climate of LCSD by participating in focus groups and reviewing progress reports from the superintendent.
